This letter is to confirm that Mr. Jeff Warner has been employed by The Prince Royal's College in Chiang Mai, Thailand, from May 2010 to the present time. The Prince Royal's College is a K-12 private Christian School founded in 1887 by American missionaries and today has a student population of over 6,000 students. All of our subjects are taught in Thai.

Mr. Warner teaches English to Thai children at the elementary level, grades 5 and 6. English is taught as a second language in Thailand and at the elementary grade levels Thai students generally have poor English skills. Mr. Warner has done a wonderful job of helping our students learn to use English. During Mr. Warner's first semester at the school he struggled with trying to understand how to reach and motivate his students. One big problem was the lack of the students' ability with English. Mr. Warner was able to figure how to overcome that difficulty and has made great inroads with his students. He now has good interaction with the students at the elementary grade level.

While working with Mr. Warner I have been impressed with his professionalism. He came into a very difficult teaching assignment, without prior teaching experience and knowledge of Thai language or culture, and he found his way and created a challenging learning environment for his students. His students love him. He is firm and demands that the students perform to his standards while also being kind and understanding to the students' lack of English skills.

I have found Mr. Warner eager to suggest new ideas to our school which helps to improve our English program. I could use more teachers like Mr. Warner to help take our English program to where we want it to be.

I would highly recommend Mr. Warner for any future job he might wish to pursue. His professionalism, mature nature, and drive to be good at his job—no matter how lacking the work environment may be—makes him an asset to any organization. It has been my pleasure to work with Mr. Warner and we are grateful for all he has done at our school.
